

## **Standardized Dress Code – Clear Lake City Elementary**

### **APPROPRIATE CLOTHING FOR GIRLS AND BOYS INCLUDES:**

- Pants and walking shorts, in solid colors, appropriately sized and worn at the natural waist line.
- Girls may also wear skirts, skorts, capris, and jumpers, in solid colors. They must be no shorter than mid-thigh when seated.
- Polo or Oxford-style shirts, collared and without visible logos – in any solid color.
- Socks
- Tennis shoes are recommended for safety reasons, but not required, except for PE.
- Clothing/hair styles, which in the judgment of the building administrators, pose a health or safety hazard and/or disrupt the educational process, are not permitted.

### **INAPPROPRIATE CLOTHING FOR GIRLS AND BOYS INCLUDES:**

- Short shorts, tight fitting clothes, oversized pants or shorts, painter pants (with loops on the side), overalls, shortalls, bike shorts, sweat pants, wind pants or leggings.
- Clogs, sandals, open-back, open-toed, steel-toed, wheeled, cleated, or high-heeled shoes.

### **GYM SHOES:**

- All students must wear tennis shoes without dark soles unless the dark-soled tennis shoes are labeled and true to test non-marking.

### **OPTIONAL ACCESSORIES:**

- Sweaters, cardigans, jackets, coats, sweatshirts, and vests are allowed in the classroom over the collared shirts.
- Turtlenecks may be worn under the collared shirts.
- Minimal trim, logos and two-toned colors are acceptable on optional accessories.

### **SPECIAL EXCEPTIONS:**

- Organizational uniforms such as Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, etc. are allowed.
- Student Council members and Choir members may wear their special shirts with approved pants/shorts/skirts/skorts/jumpers on days designated by their sponsors.
- “Spirit Day” – Every Friday students are encouraged to wear a CLCE themed shirt or school colors, royal blue and gold, with approved pants/shorts, etc.
- “Free Dress Day” – On the last Friday of each month, students may dress as they wish within the guidelines of the CCISD dress code.
- Other “Special Dress Days” will be posted on the school calendar and will appear in the school newsletter and/or memos sent home.

**The building administrators determine whether a student’s dress is appropriate.**
